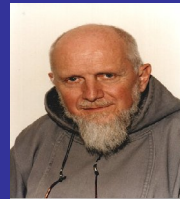
October 15, 2007: “Ghetto Love: Bring Christ to the Streets” Speaker: Michael Grogan – Founder of the Madonna of the Street Ministries
